Here is a weird one. Sometimes IE sounds like the letter name E:

field shield thief belief
believe relieve Debbie Katie

You can also see it in some plural words. When a y comes after a vowel we just add an s, like in *day* we write *days* and for *key* we write *keys*. But if the y doesn't come after a vowel, if it comes after a consonant, we write it like this:

party parties daisy daisies
baby babies puppy puppies

The thief stole the daisies for the parties.

The puppies are playing in the field.

I believe a nap will relieve the babies.
