Day 1

All the persons who came from the loins of Jacob were seventy in number, but Joseph was already in Egypt.

Day 2

He said to his people, "Behold, the people of the sons of Israel are more and mightier than we."

Day 3

But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and the more they spread out, so that they were in dread of the sons of Israel.

Day 4

But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt had commanded them, but let the boys live.

Day 5

The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

He makes me lie down in green pastures;

He leads me beside quiet waters. Psalm 23:1-2

Day 6

But when she could hide him no longer, she got him a wicker basket and covered it over with tar and pitch.

Day 7

Then Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Take this child away and nurse him for me and I will give you your wages."

Day 8

But he said, "Who made you a prince or a judge over us? Are you intending to kill me as you killed the Egyptian?"

Day 9

He said to his daughters, "Where is he then? Why is it that you have left the man behind? Invite him to have something to eat."

Day 10

He restores my soul; He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake. Psalm 23:3

Day 11

The angel of the Lord appeared to him in a blazing fire from the midst of a bush; and he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, yet the bush was not consumed.

Day 12

When the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am."

Day 13

Then Moses said to God, "Behold, I am going to the sons of Israel, and I will say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you."

Day 14

Then Moses said, "What if they will not believe me or listen to what I say? For they may say, The Lord has not appeared to you."

Day 15

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. Psalm 23:4

Day 16

"If they will not believe you or heed the witness of the first sign, they may believe the witness of the last sign."

Day 17

The Lord said to him, "Who has made man's mouth? Or who makes him mute or deaf, or seeing or blind? Is it not I, the Lord?"

Day 18

You are to speak to him and put the words in his mouth; and I, even I, will be with your mouth and his mouth, and I will teach you what you are to do.

Day 19

Now the Lord said to Moses in Midian, "Go back to Egypt, for all the men who were seeking your life are dead."

Day 20

*You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;
You have anointed my head with oil; My cup overflows.
Psalm 23:5*

Day 21

Then they said, "The God of the Hebrews has met with us. Please, let us go a three days' journey into the wilderness that we may sacrifice to the Lord our God."

Day 22

So the people scattered through all the land of Egypt to gather stubble for straw.

Day 23

The foremen of the sons of Israel saw that they were in trouble because they were told, "You must not reduce your daily amount of bricks."

Day 24

When they left Pharaoh's presence, they met Moses and Aaron as they were waiting for them.

Day 25

Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life, And I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever. Psalm 23:6

Day 36

Furthermore I have heard the groaning of the sons of Israel, because the Egyptians are holding them in bondage, and I have remembered My covenant.

Day 37

Then the Lord spoke to Moses and to Aaron, and gave them a charge to the sons of Israel and to Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring the sons of Israel out of the land of Egypt.

Day 38

The sons of Kohath: Amram and Izhar and Hebron and Uzziel; and the length of Kohath's life was one hundred and thirty-three years.

Day 39

The sons of Merari: Mahli and Mushi. These are the families of the Levites according to their generations.

Day 40

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim release to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, to set free those who are oppressed." Luke 4:18

Day 41

You shall speak all that I command you, and your brother Aaron shall speak to Pharaoh that he let the sons of Israel go out of his land.

Day 42

When Pharaoh speaks to you, saying, 'Work a miracle,' then you shall say to Aaron, 'Take your staff and throw it down before Pharaoh, that it may become a serpent.'"

Day 43

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Pharaoh's heart is stubborn; he refuses to let the people go."

Day 44

So all the Egyptians dug around the Nile for water to drink, for they could not drink of the water of the Nile.

Day 45

How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers! Psalm 1:1

Day 46

Then Moses and Aaron went out from Pharaoh, and Moses cried to the Lord concerning the frogs which He had inflicted upon Pharaoh.

Day 47

Then the magicians said to Pharaoh, "This is the finger of God." But Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he did not listen to them, as the Lord had said.

Day 48

But on that day I will set apart the land of Goshen, where My people are living, so that no swarms of flies will be there, in order that you may know that I, the Lord, am in the midst of the land.

Day 49

We must go a three days' journey into the wilderness and sacrifice to the Lord our God as He commands us."

Day 50

"But go and learn what this means: 'I DESIRE COMPASSION, AND NOT SACRIFICE,' for I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners." Matthew 9:13

Day 51

So the Lord did this thing on the next day, and all the livestock of Egypt died; but of the livestock of the sons of Israel, not one died.

Day 52

The magicians could not stand before Moses because of the boils, for the boils were on the magicians as well as on all the Egyptians.

Day 53

But, indeed, for this reason I have allowed you to remain, in order to show you My power and in order to proclaim My name through all the earth.

Day 54

The hail struck all that was in the field through all the land of Egypt, both man and beast; the hail also struck every plant of the field and shattered every tree of the field.

Day 55

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction. Proverbs 1:7

Day 56

Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he did not let the sons of Israel go, just as the Lord had spoken through Moses.

Day 57

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Go to Pharaoh, for I have hardened his heart and the heart of his servants, that I may perform these signs of Mine among them."

Day 58

"Not so! Go now, the men among you, and serve the Lord, for that is what you desire." So they were driven out from Pharaoh's presence.

Day 59

The locusts came up over all the land of Egypt and settled in all the territory of Egypt; they were very numerous. There had never been so many locusts, nor would there be so many again.

Day 60

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. Ephesians 2:8,9

Day 71

At the morning watch, the Lord looked down on the army of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and cloud and brought the army of the Egyptians into confusion.

Day 72

*Your right hand, O Lord, is majestic in power,
Your right hand, O Lord, shatters the enemy.*

Day 73

Miriam answered them, "Sing to the Lord, for He is highly exalted; The horse and his rider He has hurled into the sea."

Day 74

Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea, and they went out into the wilderness of Shur; and they went three days in the wilderness and found no water.

Day 75

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace. Ephesians 1:7

Day 76

So it came about at evening that the quails came up and covered the camp, and in the morning there was a layer of dew around the camp.

Day 77

So they put it aside until morning, as Moses had ordered, and it did not become foul nor was there any worm in it.

Day 78

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Write this in a book as a memorial and recite it to Joshua, that I will utterly blot out the memory of Amalek from under heaven."

Day 79

It came about the next day that Moses sat to judge the people, and the people stood about Moses from the morning until the evening.

Day 80

And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19

Day 81

All the people answered together and said, "All that the Lord has spoken we will do!" And Moses brought back the words of the people to the Lord.

Day 82

So it came about on the third day, when it was morning, that there were thunder and lightning flashes and a thick cloud upon the mountain and a very loud trumpet sound, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled.

Day 83

When the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke and God answered him with thunder.

Day 84

All the people perceived the thunder and the lightning flashes and the sound of the trumpet and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood at a distance.

Day 85

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me. Galatians 2:20

Day 86

He who kidnaps a man, whether he sells him or he is found in his possession, shall surely be put to death.

Day 87

And if he knocks out a tooth of his male or female slave, he shall let him go free on account of his tooth.

Day 88

If what he stole is actually found alive in his possession, whether an ox or a donkey or a sheep, he shall pay double.

Day 89

You shall not wrong a stranger or oppress him, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt.

Day 90

If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. John 14:15

Day 91

Now concerning everything which I have said to you, be on your guard; and do not mention the name of other gods, nor let them be heard from your mouth.

Day 92

Behold, I am going to send an angel before you to guard you along the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared.

Day 93

Then Moses came and recounted to the people all the words of the Lord and all the ordinances; and all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words which the Lord has spoken we will do!"

Day 94

Now the Lord said to Moses, "Come up to Me on the mountain and remain there, and I will give you the stone tablets with the law and the commandment which I have written for their instruction."

Day 95

The Lord bless you, and keep you; The Lord make His face shine on you, And be gracious to you; The Lord lift up His countenance on you, And give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26

Day 106

The skillfully woven band, which is on it, shall be like its workmanship, of the same material: of gold, of blue and purple and scarlet material and fine twisted linen.

Day 107

Aaron shall carry the names of the sons of Israel in the breastpiece of judgment over his heart when he enters the holy place, for a memorial before the Lord continually.

Day 108

There shall be an opening at its top in the middle of it; around its opening there shall be a binding of woven work, like the opening of a coat of mail, so that it will not be torn.

Day 109

Then you shall bring Aaron and his sons to the doorway of the tent of meeting and wash them with water.

Day 110

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. 1 Peter 2:9

Day 111

The one lamb you shall offer in the morning and the other lamb you shall offer at twilight.

Day 112

You shall put this altar in front of the veil that is near the ark of the testimony, in front of the mercy seat that is over the ark of the testimony, where I will meet with you.

Day 113

Everyone who is numbered, from twenty years old and over, shall give the contribution to the Lord.

Day 114

You shall also consecrate them, that they may be most holy; whatever touches them shall be holy.

Day 115

You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain. Exodus 20:7

Day 116

It is a sign between Me and the sons of Israel forever; for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, but on the seventh day He ceased from labor, and was refreshed.

Day 117

Aaron said to them, "Tear off the gold rings which are in the ears of your wives, your sons, and your daughters, and bring them to me."

Day 118

He took the calf which they had made and burned it with fire, and ground it to powder, and scattered it over the surface of the water and made the sons of Israel drink it.

Day 119

On the next day Moses said to the people, "You yourselves have committed a great sin; and now I am going up to the Lord, perhaps I can make atonement for your sin."

Day 120

Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a sabbath of the Lord your God. Exodus 20:8-10a

Day 121

And He said, "My presence shall go with you, and I will give you rest."

Day 122

The Lord descended in the cloud and stood there with him as he called upon the name of the Lord.

Day 123

Then God said, "Behold, I am going to make a covenant. Before all your people I will perform miracles which have not been produced in all the earth nor among any of the nations."

Day 124

So he was there with the Lord forty days and forty nights; he did not eat bread or drink water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.

Day 125

Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the Lord your God gives you. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal. Exodus 20:12-15

Day 126

Let every skillful man among you come, and make all that the Lord has commanded.

Day 127

And He has filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding and in knowledge and in all craftsmanship.

Day 128

And all the skillful men who were performing all the work of the sanctuary came, each from the work which he was performing.

Day 129

They were double beneath, and together they were complete to its top to the first ring; thus he did with both of them for the two corners.

Day 130

You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife or his male servant or his female servant or his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor. Exodus 20:16-17a
