

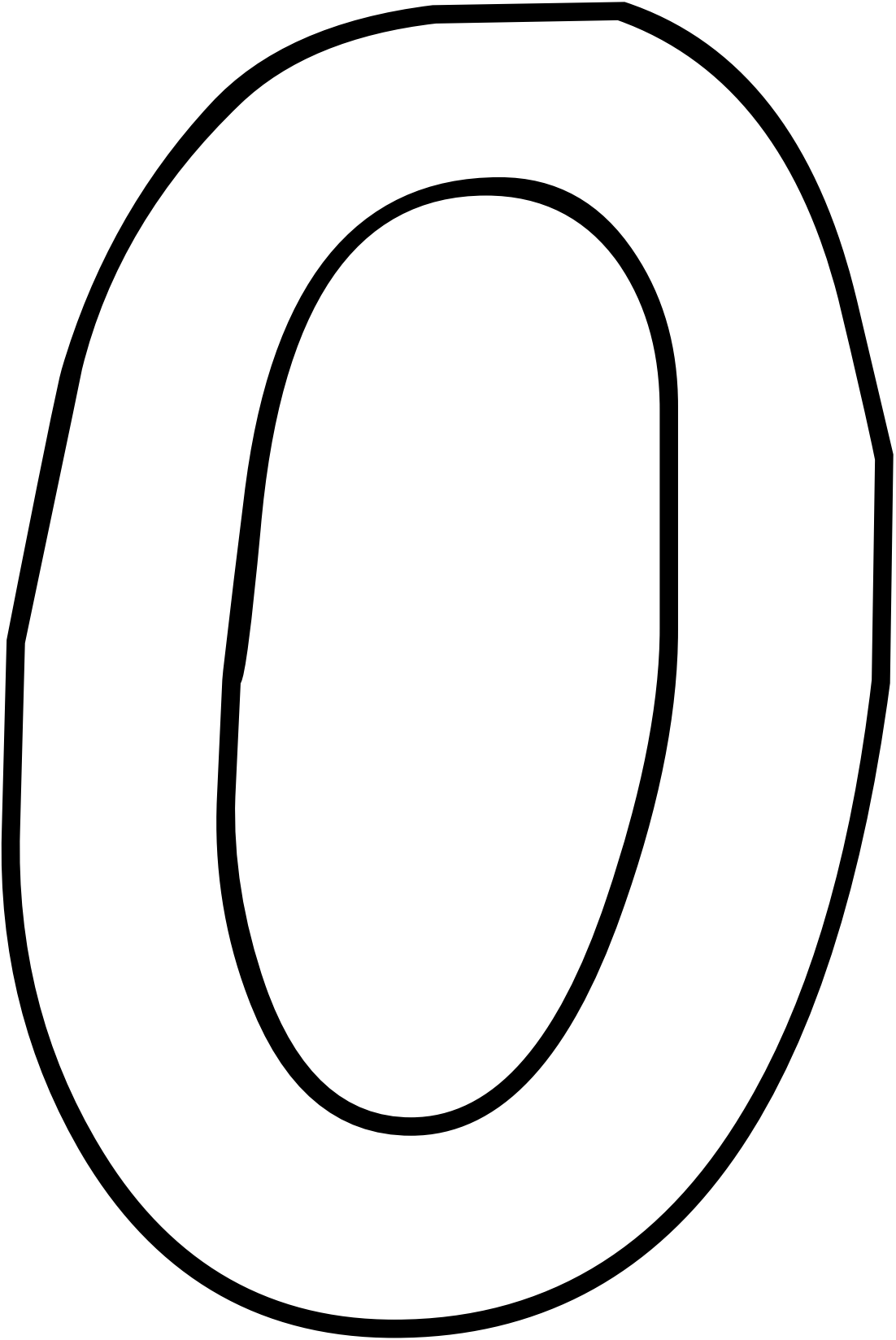

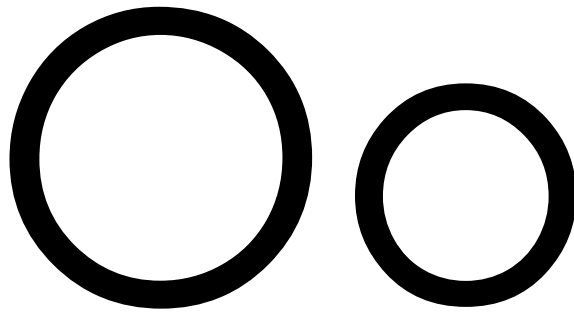
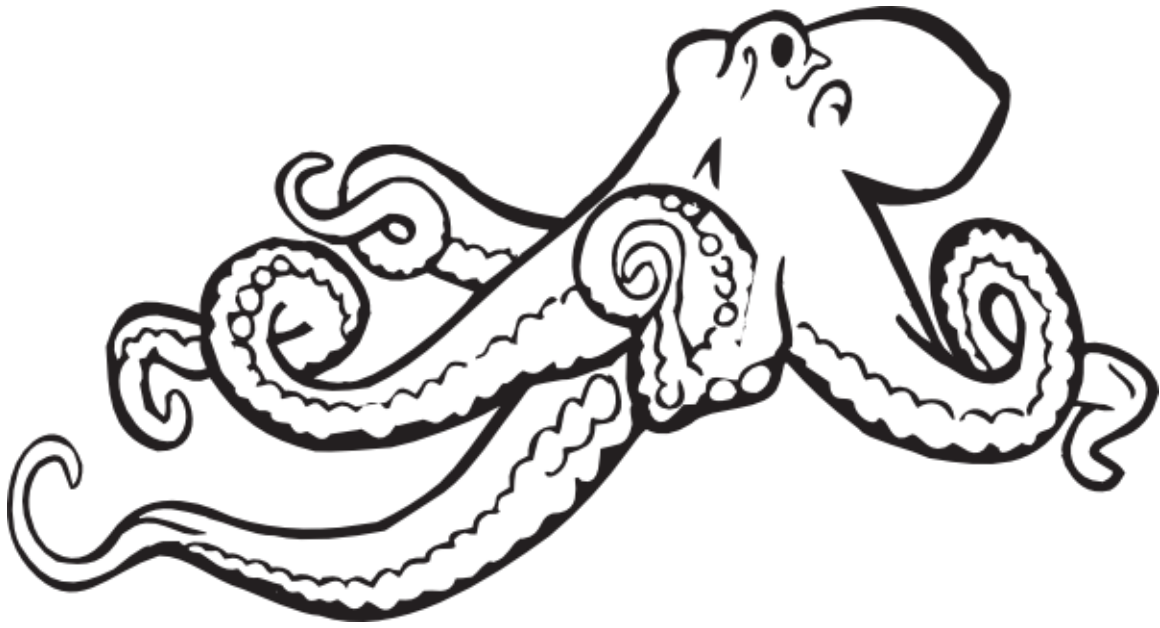
First Step

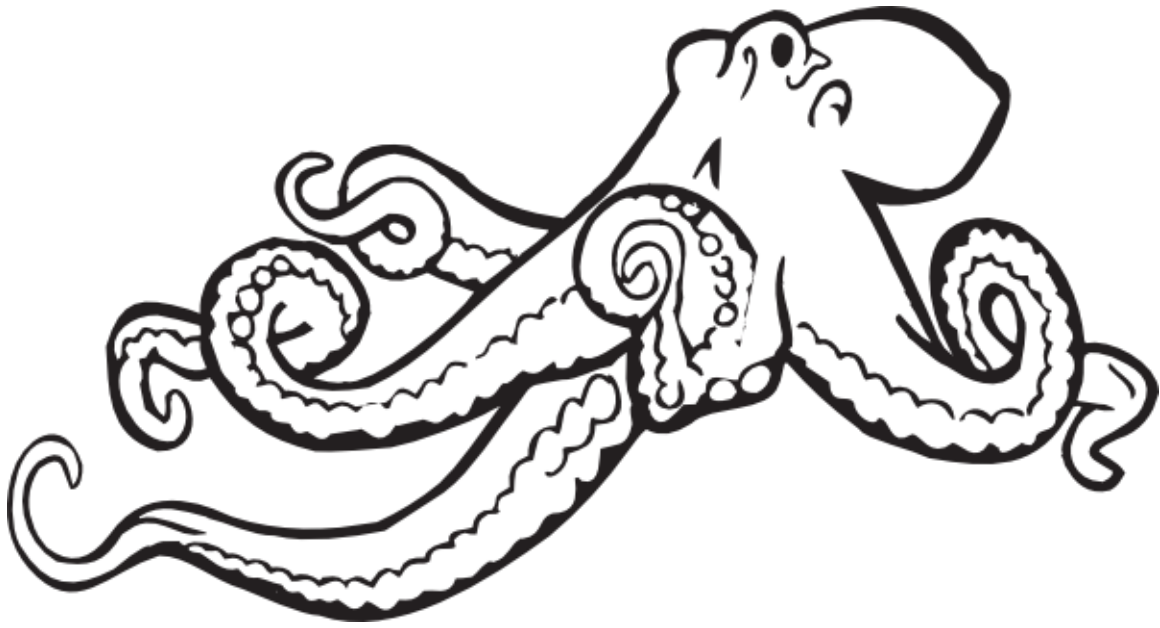
Review weeks are throughout the course. In the sample the oval page is the beginning of a review week.

The Letter O says, "O."

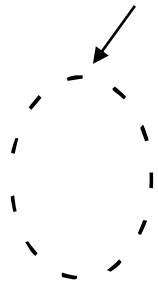
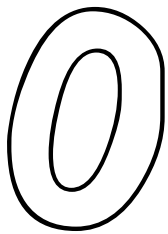
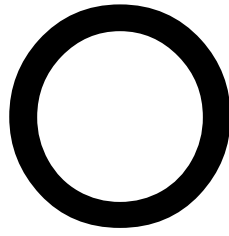
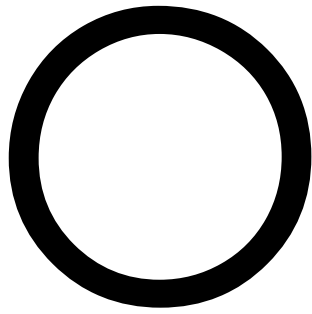
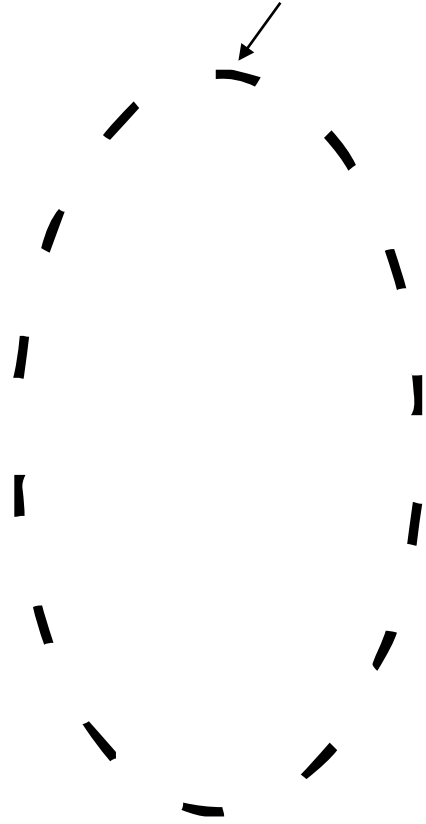
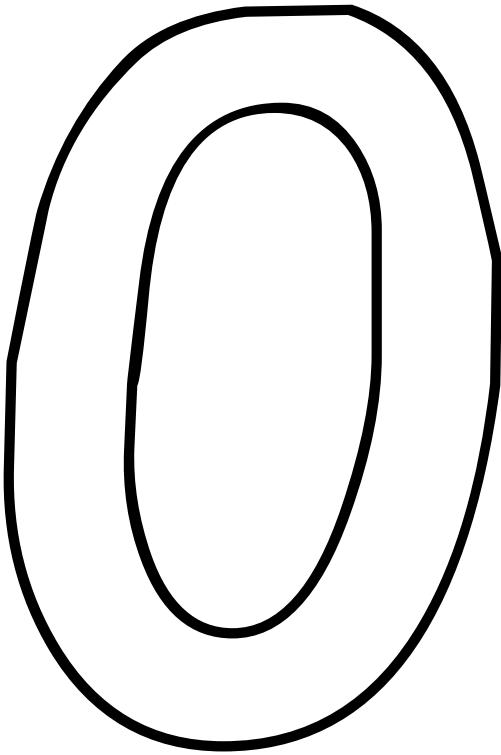
