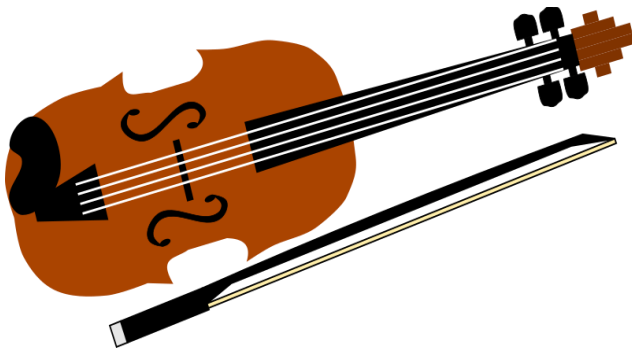
What is your favorite instrument and which family does it belong to?
