Course Description:

Students will grow in their reading ability, reading both poetry and full-length novels. Students will practice retelling and summarizing stories as well as reading aloud in front of audiences. They will demonstrate comprehension through reading response questions. Students will also grow in their writing ability, learning by copying literature as well as by creating their own stories and producing a short piece of non-fiction. Their technical writing ability will be expanded by learning to write complex sentences. Students will continue to expand their vocabulary and spelling knowledge using worksheets as well as online games and activities. Grammar topics include capitalization, punctuation, sentence structure, nouns, pronouns and verbs.
