







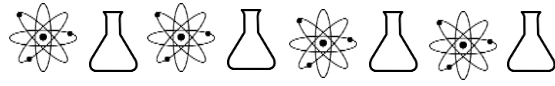


# Vocabulary Matching
