


# Adaptation

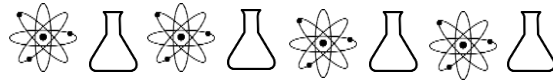
How do weasels adapt for winter?
