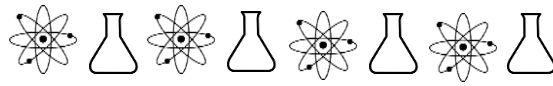


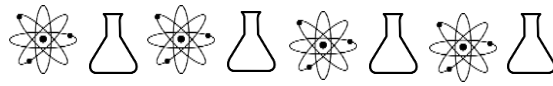
Dinosaurs

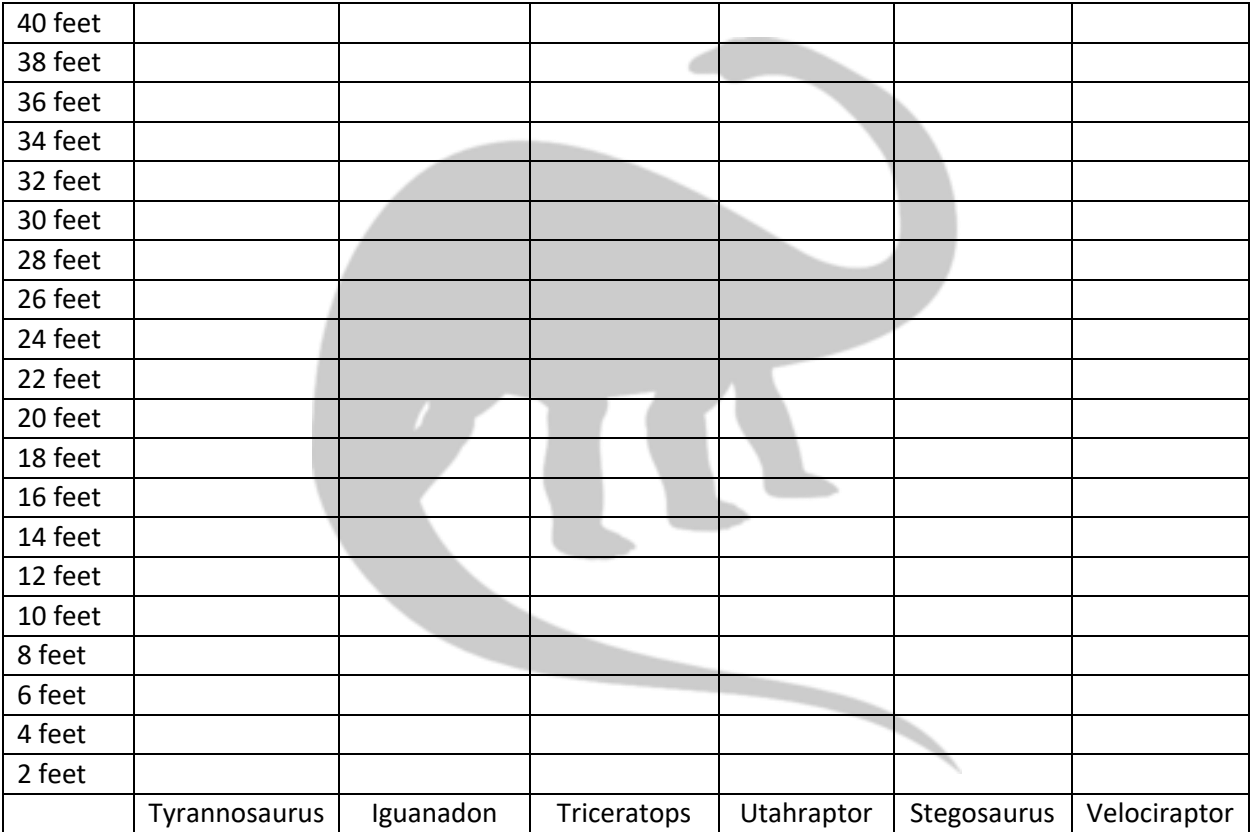
