



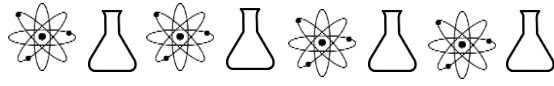



Types of Ants

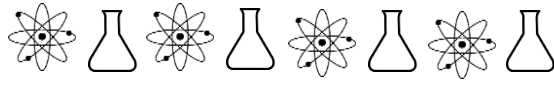
