- 3. Rabbi means teacher. Messiah, here, means the deliverer, or savior, that God promised Israel.
- 4. Check your answers.
- 5. This is the end of your work for this course for your first day. You are allowed to move at your own pace (this is homeschooling), but it's intended you complete one lesson a day.

- 1. Read John 2.
- 2. What did Jesus use to make the wine?
- 3. What was the water usually used for?

- 5. I find that an interesting question. Jesus will later equate wine with His blood. It His blood, we are told, that washes us clean from our sins. In this story we have a picture of the blood cleansing what is filthy and making it not just new, but the best!

- 1. Read John 4:43-54.
- 2. How did the man know that his son got better because of Jesus?
- 3. The man's whole household believed in Jesus. Why?
- 4. Look at verse 48. Does Jesus want us to believe because we see miracles?
- 5. Jesus will later say how we're blessed when we believe without seeing (John 20:29).
- 6. Check your answers.

Lesson 5

- 1. Read John 5:16-30.
- 2. Why were the Pharisees upset with Jesus?
- 3. How can Jesus say that He can do nothing by Himself?
- 4. In Philippians it talks about Jesus emptying Himself and taking on the form of a servant. Jesus submitted to the Father in everything. He didn't come to do His own thing, but His Father's will. He did nothing apart from what the Father gave Him to do.
- 5. Check your answers.
