- 1. Read John 2.
- 2. It says Jesus revealed His glory. What did He reveal? What did He show?
- 3. He showed His power, but I think He also showed His goodness. His mother wasn't asking Him to put on a show, and Jesus acts discretely. He's not trying to show off His power. His mother wants Him to help. Jesus showed His goodness, His compassion. Someone needed help and He gave it.

Lesson 5


- 1. Read John 5.
